Under Tennessee Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, title 44, chapter 20.

Any person who rides, drives or otherwise participates directly with the horses is regarded as a participant. This covers all horses that are on or brought onto the property of Morning Star Farm, whether owned by Morning Star or not.

This Release will remain constantly in effect for a period of 5 years from the date of this Release.

1. Participant holds Morning Star, all successors, assigns, subsidiaries, franchises, affiliates, officers, directors, employees and agents completely harmless and not liable and releases them from all liability whatsoever and agrees not to sue them on account of or in connections with any claims, causes of action, injuries, damages, costs or expenses arising out of Participant's use of or presence upon Morning Star's property and facilities, including without limitation, those based on death, bodily injury, property damage, including consequential damages.

2. Participant is responsible for the full and complete insurance coverage on his/her horse, personal property and self.

3. Participant agrees to abide by all Morning Star's rules and regulations and Participant is responsible for using protective gear.
